- 2. Vocational Promise: Recipients shall posses aboveaverage potentialities for success in their chosen field of work as indicated by past record, test data and other supplemental information.
- 3. Character: Recipients shall be of good character and have a record of good citizenship.
- li. Financial Need: Recipients shall be those whose educational opportunities will be bettered by receiving financial aid under these scholarships.
